Costs

Nomination fee = \$30 (\$40 if late)

Initial Squad fee = \$60 (Announced at trials)

Training Squad = \$160 (Announced in May)

Competition levy = \$2100 (3 instalments of \$700 as listed above)

This includes flights, vehicle hire, accommodation, tournament nomination fees and 3 meals daily at the AIS.

Please note: Uniforms are an additional cost.
