#### Level 1 Referee

A referee is accredited as a Level 1 Referee when they successfully complete the following requirements:

- 1. The candidate must be at least 12 years old.
- 2. Be a registered member of your State Volleyball Association.
- Complete the Play by the Rules <u>Child Protection</u> and <u>Harassment</u> <u>& Discrimination</u> Online Courses.
- 4. Complete the online Volleyball Australia Level 1 Referee course.
- 5. Agree and sign the <u>VA Officials'</u> <u>Code of Behaviour</u>

### Level 2 Referee

A referee is accredited as a Level 2 Referee when they successfully complete the following requirements:

- 1. The candidate must be at least 14 years old
- 2. The candidate must have a Volleyball Australia Level 1 Referee Accreditation
- 3. Be a registered member of your State Volleyball Association
- 4. Attend the Level 2 face-to-face Referee course.
- 5. Complete the Community Officiating General Principles Course
- 6. Meet the required <u>competencies</u> for a Level 2 Referee. The minimum number of games required are:
  - # 3 games as a 1st Referee (1x assessment\*\* for competency\*\*\*)
  - # 3 games as a 2nd Referee (1x assessment\*\* for competency\*\*\*)
  - # 2 games as a Scorer
  - # 2 games as a Line Referee
- 7. Agree and sign the VA Officials' Code of Behaviour

Level 3 & 4 Referee Must meet the required competencies, plus...

#### Level 3:

- 1. Must be at least 16
- 2. Must have a level 2

#### Level 4:

- 1. Must be at least 18
- 2. Must have a level 3

- \* Schools contact VQ if you would like a bulk upload and payment option
- \*\* Schools VQ plan to host a workshop at each Schools Cup so teachers/coaches can be an approved assessor for Level 2 Candidates. Assessors will need to attend a refresher every two years.
- \*\*\* VQ Schools Cups, PVL, State Championships, QBVT Qld Open and/or AVSC are a great place to be assessed.
