

VQ Schools Cup Spectator Guide



The following principles apply to all VQ Schools Cup Venues:

- If are feeling ill or unwell... do not attend
- Each team will be permitted a maximum of **5 x spectators** per match
- 5 x wristbands (honours teams) or tickets (non-honours teams) will be issued to the team coach – no other person is authorised to collect wristbands/tickets
- The team coach must sign the wristband/ticket register once they have collected their allocation
- The Team coach must distribute the wristband/tickets to their spectators at an area away from the venue entrance (to avoid crowding/maintain social distancing).
- Spectators must 'check in' on arrival. A QR Code will be available - all spectators must scan in using their phone camera or QR Scanner; enter your details and show your 'green tick' at the door. (Manual signing is also available and must be done if the QR Code is not used).
- Spectators with tickets must hand these over upon entering the venue
- Spectators will only be permitted to enter the venue after the previous matches spectators have exited – please stand clear of the door way while waiting
- Spectators are only permitted in the designated spectator zones – these will vary by venue
- Spectators must social distance at 4sqm at all times
- Spectator seating is only available in some zones/venues. Others are standing only (spectators are not permitted to bring their own chairs unless required for mobility/accessibility issues)
- At the completion of a match all spectators must leave the venue immediately: 'check out' not required

There will be "zero tolerance" for violent, aggressive or offensive behaviour to Gold Coast Sports & Leisure and VQ staff

Centre Management and VQ reserves the right to refuse entry to any person/s who fail to comply with the conditions of entry
