Costs

- Athletes will need an official referee qualification to participate in NYBC (further information to follow, including additional costs)

Athletes must travel and compete in the official Volleyball Queensland uniform which consists of:

- <u>On-court</u>
 - 2 x playing tops
 - 1 x playing bottom
 - 1 x VQ cap/visor

1 x Volleyball Queensland Travel Shirt

The uniform items are the same as used for 2020 AJBVC (on-court & off-court) & 2017-19 AJVC (off-court) tournaments so athletes are welcome to re-use their existing uniform provided the condition is satisfactory.

Off-court

Uniform ordering details will be provided before final team selections.

Additional optional official VQ items will also be available for purchase (information to follow).

Please note, if an athlete withdraws prior to travelling the uniform must be returned and a refund of the uniform cost will be provided.

Meals

Evening meals - will be provided (details to follow)

Breakfasts & lunches - athletes will purchase and organise their own lunchess for the duration of the tournament at their own expense. The accommodation is apartment-style and each room contains cooking facilities and a laundry. It is anticipated that the squad will be broken into smaller groups and cater for themselves, with the assistance of team coaches. This will be discussed further at training.

Accommodation

All athletes are required to stay with the delegation.

The teams and coaches are booked in to:

Oaks Calypso Plaza (99 Griffith St) and Mantra Coolangatta (88 Marine Parade)

The hotels are side-by-side and directy across the road from the beach & courts

(We ask that parents/supports attending the event use alternative accommodation to that of the Qld teams.)
