

# U14/15 Boys

## Entries

- 5 x U14 & 9 x U15 Teams Entered

## Pool Play

- All entries are combined for initial pool play
- Teams are seeded and divided into 2 pools of 7
- Team play a full pool round robin. I.E. each team plays 6 games
- U14 won't play each other in initial pool play
- At the end of pool play, the U14 & U15 teams are separated for finals

## U14 Finals

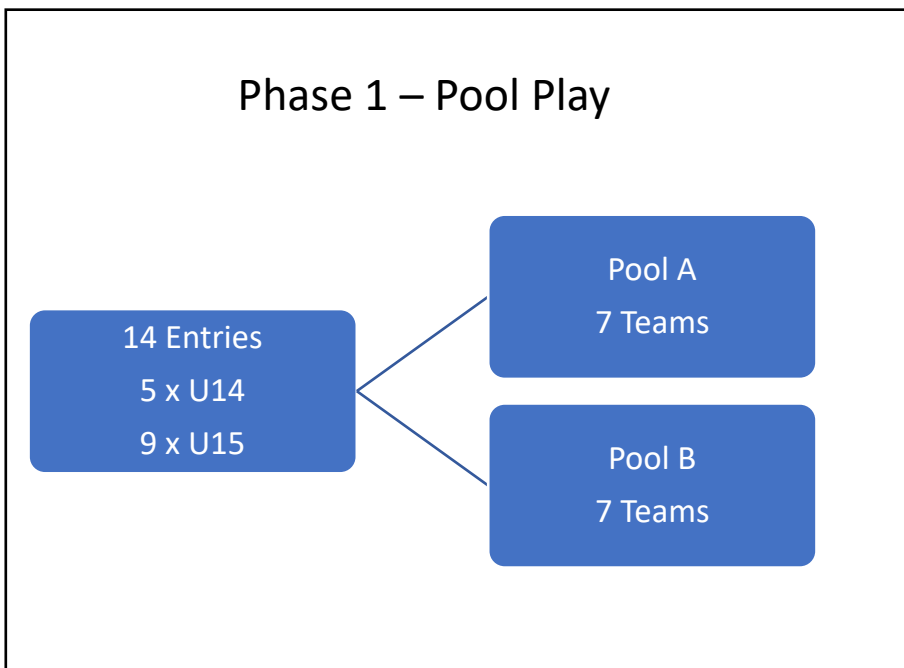
- The 5 teams are seeded based on their pool play results
- Play pool play round robin
- Top team straight to Gold
- Teams that finish 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> play in SF, loser gets Bronze
- Teams that finish 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> Playoff for final placings

## U15 Finals

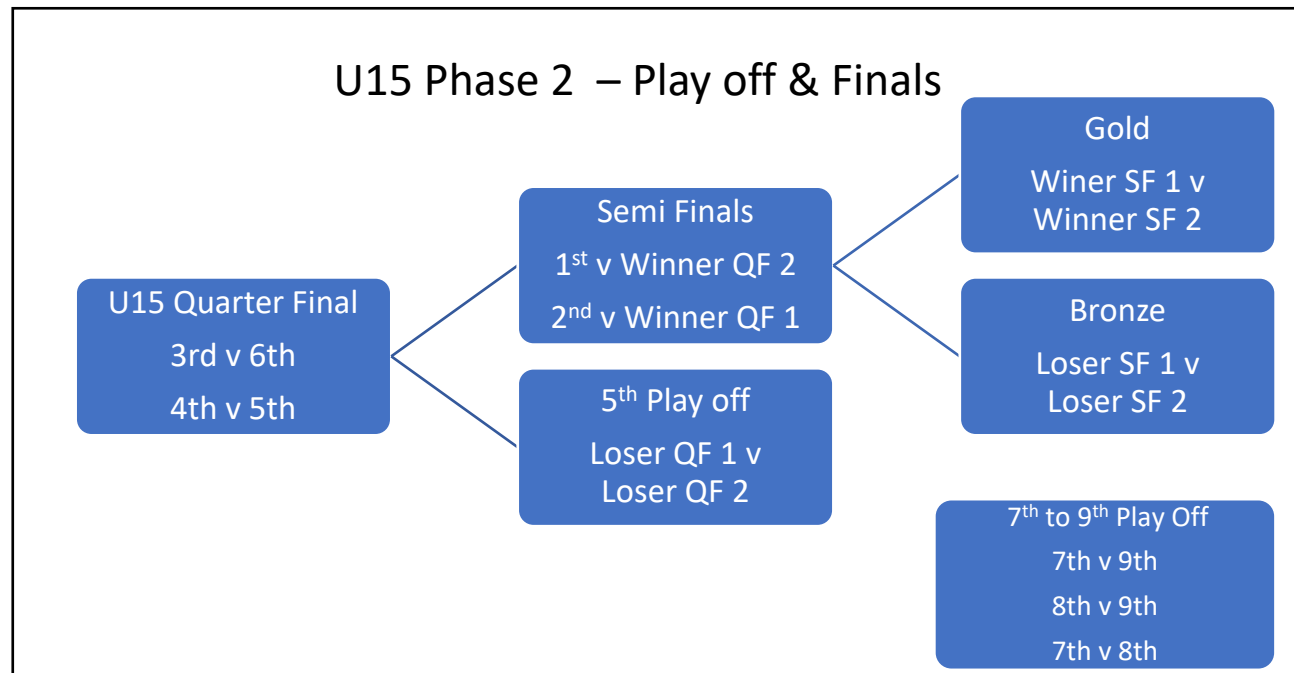
- The 9 teams are seeded based on their pool play results of ALL games (once U14 teams come out)
- 7<sup>th</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup> play a Play Off Round Robin of 3 matches (2 games per team)
- 3<sup>rd</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> play a modified cross over Quarter Final of 3<sup>rd</sup> v 6<sup>th</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> v 5<sup>th</sup>
- Losers of the QF to play off for 5<sup>th</sup>
- Winner of 3<sup>rd</sup> vs 6<sup>th</sup> to play 2<sup>nd</sup> and winner of 4<sup>th</sup> v 5<sup>th</sup> to play 1<sup>st</sup> in the Semi Finals.
- Losers of SF to play for Bronze and Winner of SF to play for the Gold Medal



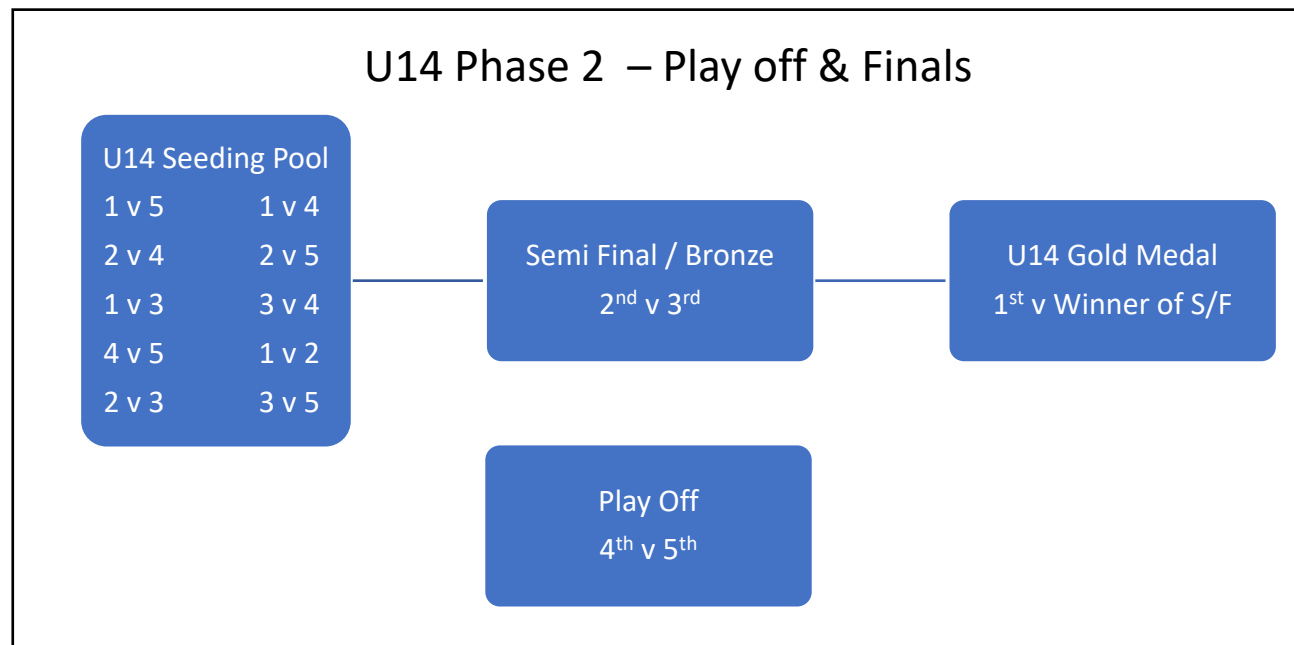
### Phase 1 – Pool Play

- All teams will play 3 games

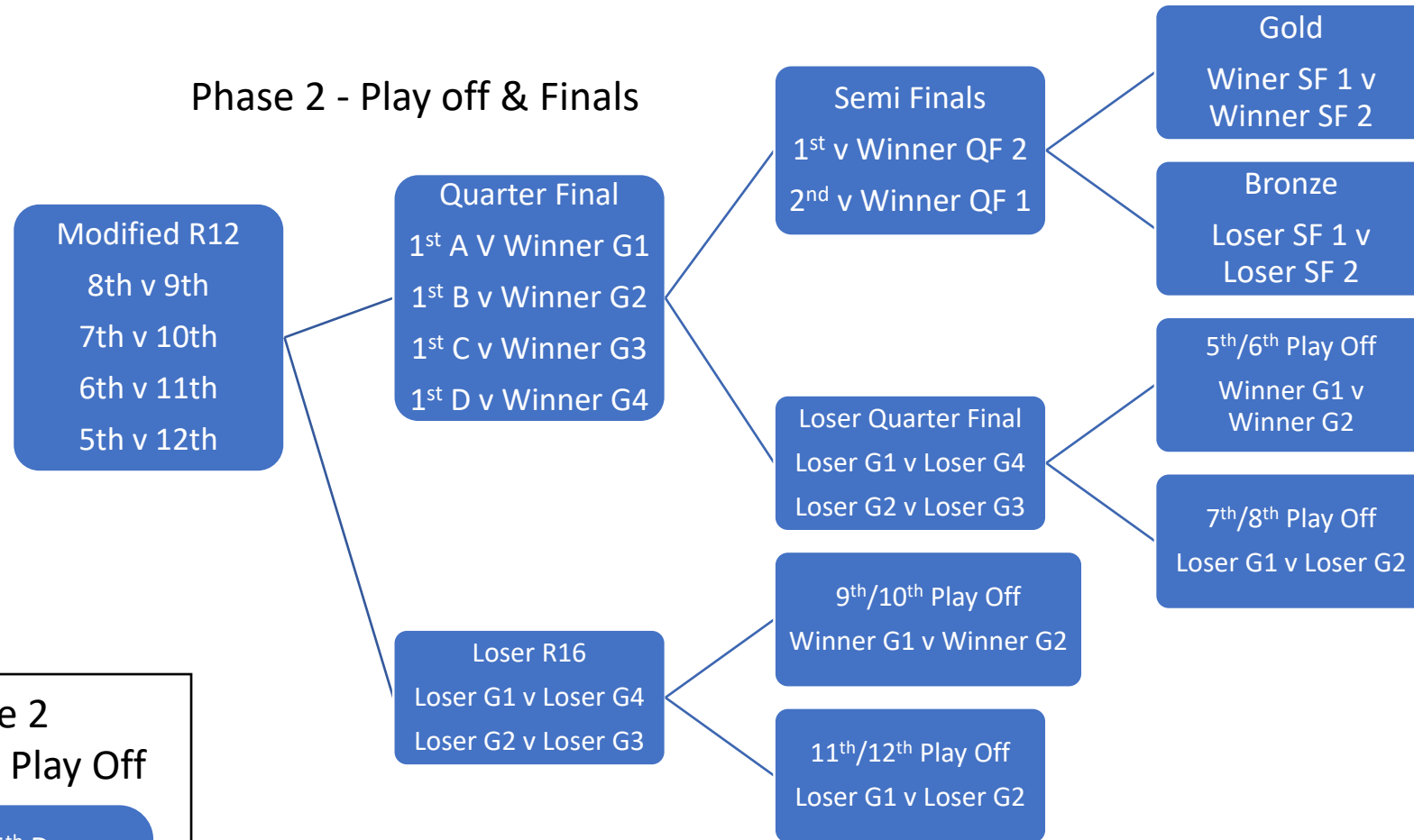
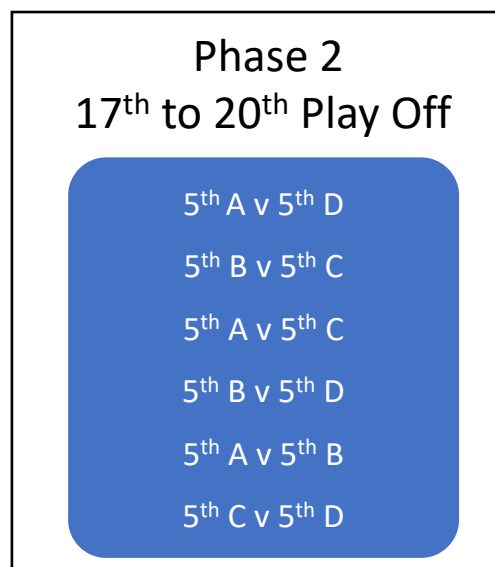
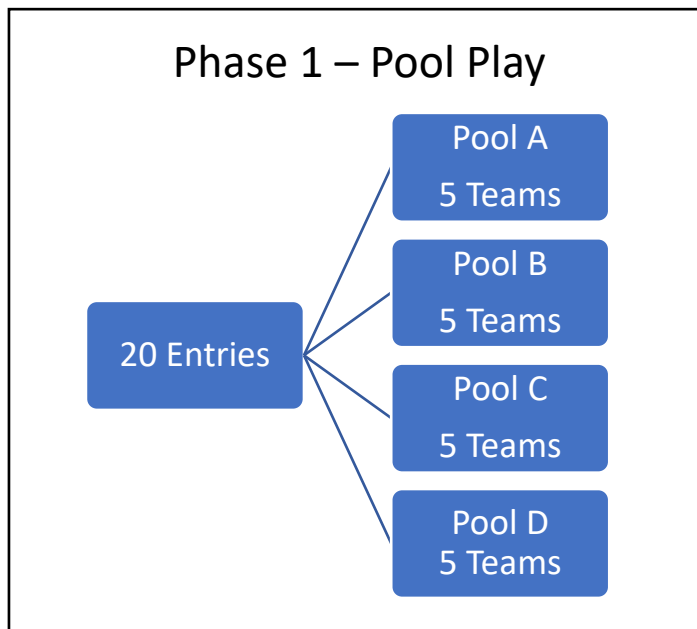
## All 5<sup>th</sup> Place teams in Playoff Pool (total of 4 teams)

  - 1<sup>st</sup> = 1<sup>st</sup> A, 2<sup>nd</sup> = 1<sup>st</sup> B, 3<sup>rd</sup> = 1<sup>st</sup> C, 4<sup>th</sup> = 1<sup>st</sup> D
- Teams 5<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> to play in Round of 12
  - 5<sup>th</sup> = 2<sup>nd</sup> D, 6<sup>th</sup> = 2<sup>nd</sup> C, 7<sup>th</sup> = 2<sup>nd</sup> B, 8<sup>th</sup> = 2<sup>nd</sup> A
  - 9<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> drawn
  - Winners to QF
  - Losers to Playoffs

- Teams seeded 5<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> will be seeded 3<sup>rd</sup> B, 3<sup>rd</sup> A, 4<sup>th</sup> A then 4<sup>th</sup> B to avoid teams from the same pools playing each other in the Quarter finals.
- Full Quarter Final round is played
- Losers of Quarter Finals play a modified pool play format to finish 5<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup>
- Winner of Quarter Finals play in Semi Finals
- Losers of Semi Finals Play in the Bronze Medal Match

- Teams seeded 5<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> will be seeded 3<sup>rd</sup> B, 3<sup>rd</sup> A, 4<sup>th</sup> A then 4<sup>th</sup> B to avoid teams from the same pools playing each other in the Quarter finals.
- Full Quarter Final round is played
- Losers of Quarter Finals play a modified pool play format to finish 5<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup>
- Winner of Quarter Finals play in Semi Finals

## Entries

## Pool Play

- All entries are combined for initial pool play
- Teams are seeded and divided into 2 pools of 7
- Team play a full pool round robin. I.E. each team plays 6 games
- U14 won't play each other in initial pool play
- At the end of pool play, the U14 & U15 teams are separated for finals

## U14 Finals

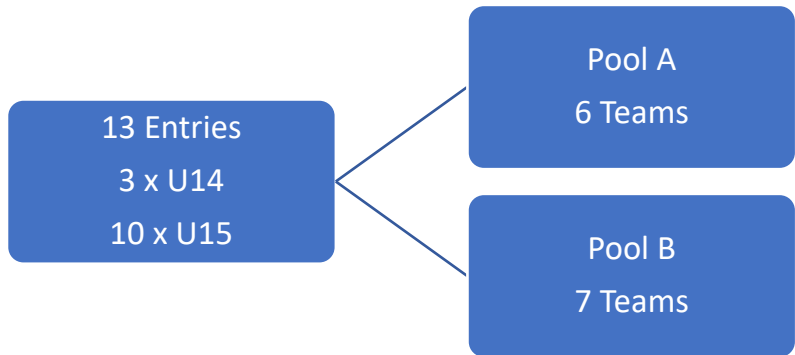
- The 3 teams are seeded based on their pool play results
- They play a 3 game round robin (2 games per team)
- Based on the 3 games only, they move into medal matches with 2nd v 3rd in a semi final with the loser to receive the Bronze Medal and the winner to play 1<sup>st</sup> in the Gold Medal Match.

## U15 Finals

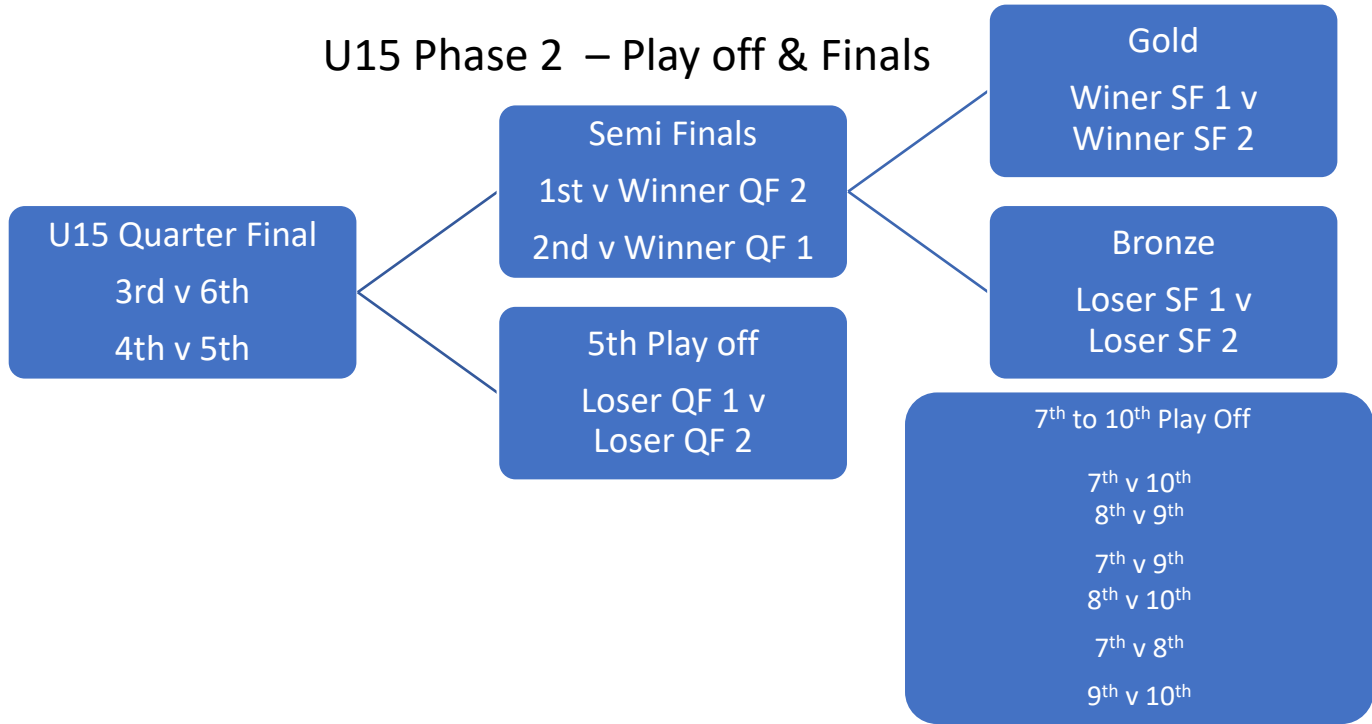
- Teams 1<sup>st</sup> in each pool straight to SF
- Teams 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> in each pool to play in QF
- Teams 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> in each pool to play round robin (play for 7<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> place)
- Winner of Quarter Finals play in Semi Finals
- Losers of Quarter Finals play off for 5<sup>th</sup>
- Losers of Semi Finals Play in the Bronze Medal Match
- Winners of Semi Finals play in the Gold Medal Match

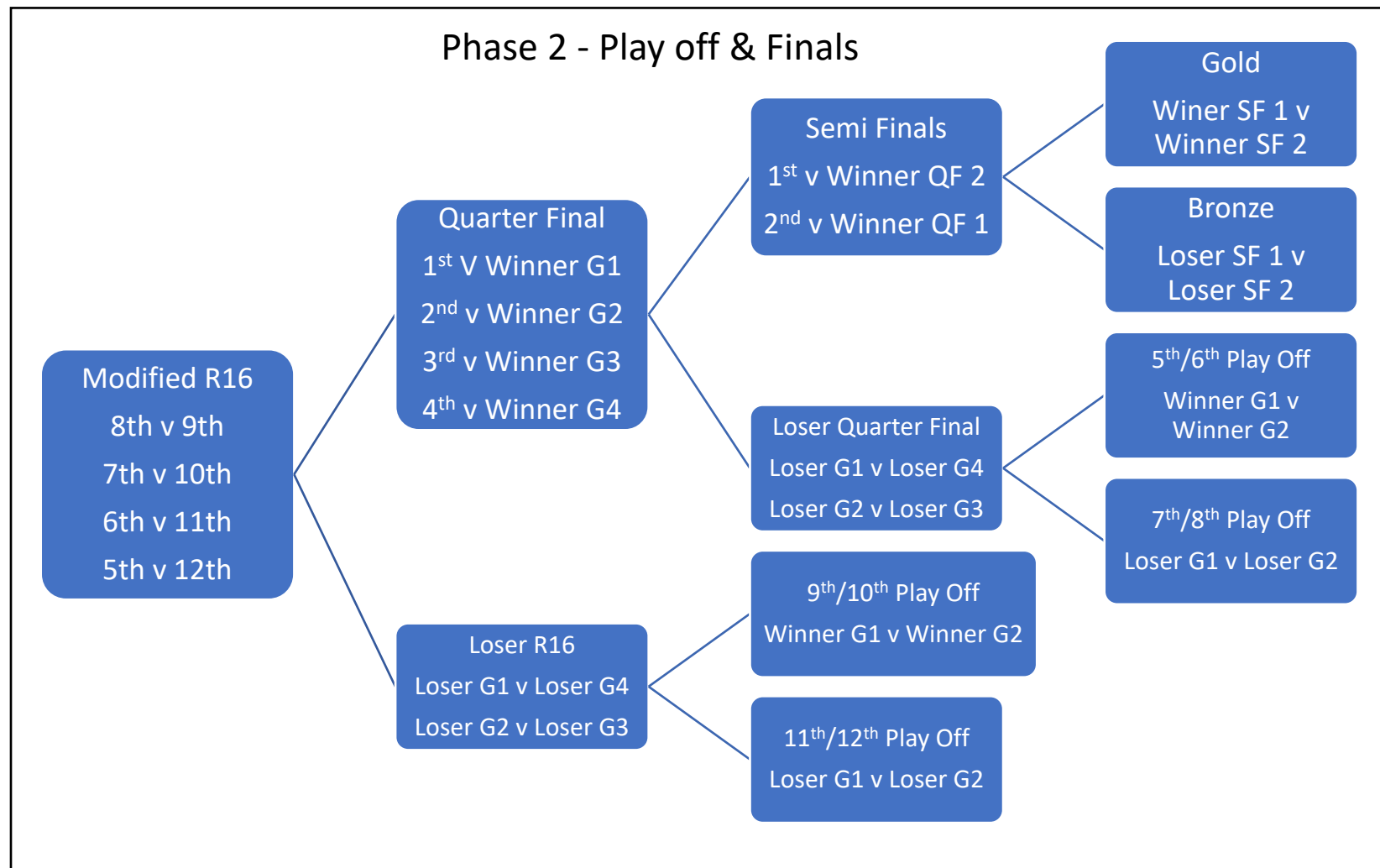
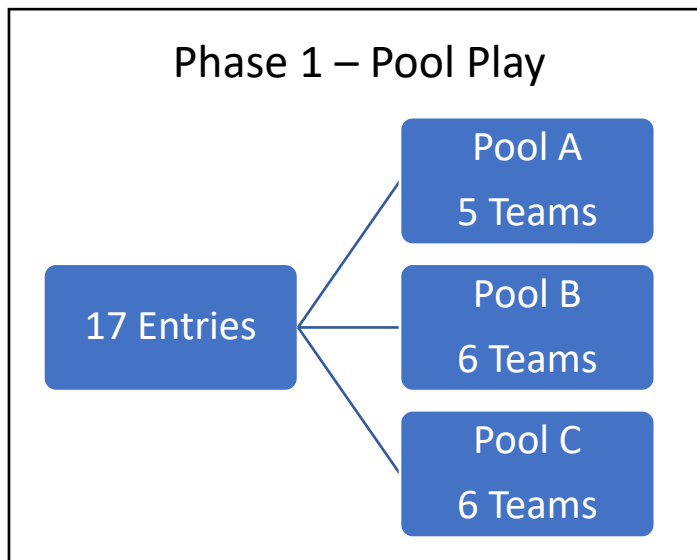

  - 4<sup>th</sup> = Best 2<sup>nd</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> Drawn from 2<sup>nd</sup>s
  - 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup> & 9<sup>th</sup> Drawn from 3<sup>rd</sup>s
  - 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> drawn from 4<sup>th</sup>s
- 5<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> play a single elimination round
- Losers of 5<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> play a modified pool play format to finish 9<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup>
- Winners play 1<sup>st</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> in a Quarter Final
