



## 2021 Primary Schools Cups COVID-Safe Measures



These measures have been developed to ensure Primary Schools Cups is carried out safely and in line with Queensland Government and Education Queensland requirements, and the VQ Return to Play COVID19-Safe Guide.

Please ensure your teams and supporters are informed accordingly.

Measure	Implications for Teams
No spectators	Only the students playing and their respective coaches, team managers and responsible adults are to attend. These will remain under the jurisdiction of their respective schools.
Contact Tracing	Schools are to provide names of all participants (students) and contact details (team adults) in advance. Any changes are to be advised on the day to VQ.
Illness	Unwell team members must stay away
Get In-Get it Done-Get Out	Upon arrival, schools are to establish a 'hub', separated from other schools. When not playing, visiting the toilet, or canteen, students are to return to their hub.
No mass 'Team Briefing'	Instead of the traditional mass briefing, each school is to run their own briefing (VQ will provide notes).
Warm-up balls	Teams are to bring their own warm-up balls. Please do not share these with other schools. VQ will provide match balls.
Sanitisation	Teams to bring own hand sanitiser and use before and during each match.
Limit contact	Teams to avoid high-fives, handshakes, team huddles, etc. Teams to avoid contact with the net, posts, guy ropes.
Separate court entry & exits	To avoid contact with others, teams will enter and exit via different walkways. Teams to arrive at court shortly before previous match ends – wait on the pink lines beside the court & sanitise hands. When a match ends, teams must exit the court over their baseline. Only when teams in previous match exit may new teams enter.
Results Tent	The captain of the winning team is to bring the scoresheet to the results tent, ( <u>not</u> the whole team!) Only one team representative, ideally the team adult, is to check the results boards at a time.
Canteen & Toilet	If visiting these ensure appropriate social distancing.
No Supporters	Teams are not permitted to 'spectate' matches they are not playing in, except the last round of the day (1:35pm). In this case supporters must stand on the pink lines between the courts. At the completion of the match the supporters must return immediately to their 'hub'.
No Medal Ceremony	The team responsible adult is to collect medals won at the VQ 'booth' VQ will set up a number of photo opportunities so teams can get a photo separated from others.
