

## **Metro League Frequently Asked Questions**

---

### **Where is Metro League played?**

Metro League is played at the below venues on the following nights;

- **Cornubia Park Sports Centre – Monday evenings**  
(146 Bryants Road, Shailer Park 4128)
- **Nissan Arena – Tuesday evenings**  
(590 Mains Road, Nathan 4111)
- **Logan Metro Sports & Events Centre – Wednesday evenings**  
(357 Browns Plains Road, Crestmead 4132)

### **What is the format?**

- 60 minute matches plus a 10 minute warm up/changeover
- 6:30pm, 7:50pm and 9:10pm timeslots – the time reflects the start of the match
- 10 minute intervals allocated in between timeslots for outgoing duty teams to clean volleyball equipment prior to the next timeslot
- All matches, including medal matches are “Best of five sets”
- Set 1-4 to 25 points with a two-point advantage
- Set 5 to 15 points

U19, U17 & U15 Boys & Girls
- **Nissan Arena**  
Division 1 & 2 Men & Women
- **Logan Metro Sports & Events Centre**  
Division 1 & 2 Men & Women and U19, U17 & U15 Boys & Girls

### **What are the 2022/23 season dates?**

2022/23 Metro League will be played on the following dates;

#### **Cornubia Park Sports Centre**

- **Season 1;** Monday 21 February to Monday 16 May (11 weeks)  
Monday 18 April; Easter, Monday 25 April; “bye round”
- **Season 2;** Monday 6 June to Monday 29 August (13 weeks)
- **Season 3;** Monday 10 October 2022 to Monday 30 January 2023 (14 weeks)  
3 week festive break from Monday 19 December 2022 to Monday 2 January 2023

#### **Nissan Arena**

- **Season 1;** Tuesday 22 February to Tuesday 17 May (13 weeks)
- **Season 2;** Tuesday 7 June to Tuesday 30 August (13 weeks)
- **Season 3;** Tuesday 11 October 2022 to Tuesday 31 January 2023 (14 weeks)  
3 week festive break from Tuesday 20 December 2022 to Tuesday 3 January 2023

## **Logan Metro Sports & Events Centre**

- **Season 1;** Wednesday 23 February to Wednesday 18 May (13 weeks)
- **Season 2;** Wednesday 8 June to Wednesday 24 August (10 weeks)  
Wednesday 3, 10 and 31 August; “bye round”
- **Season 3;** Wednesday 12 October 2022 to Wednesday 1 February 2023 (14 weeks)  
3 week festive break from Wednesday 21 December 2022 to Wednesday 4 January 2023

## **What are the player eligibility requirements?**

U19, U17 & U15 Boys & Girls must be under the stated age for the full year of the competition (e.g. to be eligible for the U17 Division a player cannot turn 17 in the year of the competition). Men/boys are not eligible to play in the women’s/girl’s competition matches. Women/girl’s may not play in men’s/boy’s matches (unless authorised by VQ).

## **How do team payments work?**

All teams will be required to pay for the first 2 weeks with entry; VQ will then invoice all teams the remainder of season amounts owing that must be paid in full by no later than Round 6 of each respective competition.
