## ABOUT QLD SENIOR STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS

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The 2022 QLD Senior State Championships will be offered to current Affiliate and Associate Affiliates of Volleyball Queensland (VQ), Non-Affiliate Clubs and Associations, international, interstate and school teams.

The 2022 QLD Senior State Championships will take place at Coomera Indoor Sports Centre & Runaway Bay Indoor Stadium from Saturday 1 to Monday 3 October.

There will be up to six (6) Divisions in each gender available: Division 1 A&B, Division 2 A&B and Division 3 A&B (subject to entry numbers).

## PURPOSE OF THE POSITION

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The primary responsibility of the role is the oversight of match officials through their;

- Appointment;
- Attendance;
- Performance.

which results in the smooth delivery of matches.

## DUTIES

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The Chief Referee is responsible for;

1. Liaising with teams regarding their nominated match officials.
2. Liaising with referees of suitable standard to officiate matches.
3. Creating and submitting a roster of First Referees for all medal matches.
4. Delivering any educational and/or organisational requirements specific to QLD Senior State Championships (e.g. Scoresheet Webinar).
5. Ensuring assessments are offered to referees who wish to have formal feedback and schedule these to occur.
6. Drafting any advice or directives to teams via the Competition Manager to enable matches to be delivered appropriately.
7. Attending QLD Senior State Championships staff meetings as necessary.
