Travel to AYVC tournament

Accommodation & Ground Transport

Anti-Bullying & Harassment Workshop

Following the success of this annual program since it was introduced in 2013, Volleyball Queensland will again be holding a mandatory workshop for all state team athletes, entitled “Anti-Bullying & Harassment Training Workshop”. All workshops are tailored for the specific age groups and run for 90 minutes. Coaches and parents are not allowed to observe or participate in any of the Athletes Workshops, which will be facilitated independently by *University of Queensland’s School of Sports Psychology*.

The workshop sessions will be scheduled in conjunction with the training program towards the end of September.

Attendance at these sessions is compulsory for all AYVC 2022 Training Squad members.

Volleyball Australia Level 1 Referee Accreditation

All players must hold a minimum *Volleyball Australia Level 1 Referee Accreditation*. This is an online course which can be completed through the accreditation portal (RevSport).
