

2022/23 Qld AYBVC Program

Australian Youth Beach Volleyball Championships (AYBVC)

Volleyball Queensland's junior beach volleyball teams participate annually in the Australian Youth Beach Volleyball Championships (AYBVC). In 2021, the event's name changed, previously known as the Australian Junior Beach Volleyball Championships (AJBVC) or the National Youth Beach Volleyball Championships (NYBVC) however, this tournament remains Australia's premier beach competition for male and female junior athletes. Being a state versus state competition, VQ is proud of its success at this tournament, being crowned "Champion State" every year since 2015.

The program will consist of one trial, seven training sessions and three compulsory QBVT tournaments between October 2022 and March 2023. Coaches will attend the three tournaments that are part of the program and actively coach the athletes in line with QBVT guidelines.

Trial Process:

1. **STEP 1:** Must nominate for trials by 10 October (players who do not nominate will not be considered) and indicate which trial they will be attending
2. **STEP 2:** You must:
 - a. Attend the trial on Saturday 16th October at Suttons Beach
 - b. If you are unable to attend the trial, you must indicate this in the nomination form and complete a trial exemption form indicating your reasons
 - c. If you are a regional athlete in North Queensland, you must submit a trial nomination form and we will let you know about NQ trials
3. **STEP 3:** A list of athletes who have made it to the training squad will be posted on the VQ website following the trial on 19th October
4. **STEP 4:** A list of travelling teams and shadow players will be posted on the VQ website on December 20th.

*Exemptions:

If you are a current AVA athlete, you must nominate for trials but automatically go through to the training squad.

Exempt athletes who do not submit a nomination from by 10 October will not be considered for selections.

NB: The program will also include a few educational workshops that will be organised either before or after a training session.

Queensland Squad:

Volleyball Queensland will be aiming to nominate a maximum of 5 teams* per age group and gender at AYBVC 2023. Final team entries will depend on player levels and overall logistics.

*Does not include NQ teams

Logistics:

AYBVC 2023 will be in Coolangatta from 27 to 30 March 2023. U14 and U15 squads will be required to stay with their parents during the tournament, while U16, U17 and U18 teams will be staying with the delegation.

Cost:

The final cost of the competition levy will be finalised by the end of October , however, please see an *indicative amount below. The trial fee and training squad fee have been finalised.
