

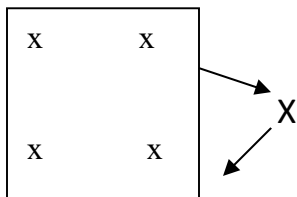
## Primary Schools Cup

# YEAR 6 Competitive Division Additional Rules

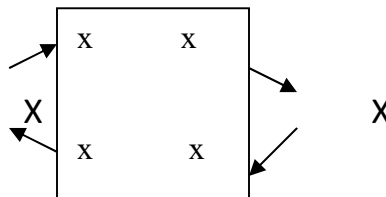


- Boys and girls teams in this division may play on a variety of surfaces – Grass, Sand and Outdoor hard-Court & Indoors (venue dependent)
- Depending on team numbers, all teams will be given the opportunity to play an equal number of games on each surface. This may not be possible, but the draw will attempt to get as close as possible to even games.
- Grand Finals will be played indoors (if possible)
- 6 players can occupy the court for all surfaces in this division.
- Net heights – 2.00m for all surfaces.
- Substitutions – unlimited rolling substitutions can be made at any time in the game between points. Match officials do not have to be advised of a substitution providing it is between points.
- Teams can make up to 2 substitutions at a time as shown below:

- Contact rules will be the same for each surface as shown below:
  - Block does not count as a touch – 3 more touches allowed even on Beach
  - Ball can be set off the serve
  - 2 touches will be called ONLY if it very obvious to the refereeing team and the player gains an advantage as a result of the touch (subjective, but all sport is!)
  - Net touches will be called for the TOP of the tape. Any other net touch will be viewed on the degree of impact that it has on the opposition. Holding onto the net to gain an advantage will be penalised. Pushing into the net to recover a ball will only be penalised if the opposition is disadvantaged or impeded.
  - Crossing under the net will only be penalised if ONE or BOTH feet completely enter the opposition teams space.
